- credit reports,

- lemon law issues, and more.

In addition to getting answers to pressing legal questions, LawNY advocates provide full representation to eligible callers in many consumer cases.

The project covers all of LawNY's counties (Monroe, Ontario, Wayne, Seneca, Yates, Livingston, Tompkins, Tioga, Allegany, Steuben, Chemung, Schuyler, Cattaraugus, and Chautauqua).

An advocate from our Consumer Law Project will call you back within three business days to speak with you and give you information about your rights.
